The Know India Programme (KIP) is organized to associate the younger generation of the Indian Diaspora closely with India. Nineteen such KIPs have been organized till now. The KIP provides a unique forum for students and young professionals of Indian origin to share their views, expectations and experience to bond closely with contemporary India. Each KIP is of three weeks duration and not exceeding 40 participants.

1. The 21st KIP is expected to commence in August 2012, in partnership with the State Government of Uttaranchal.
